The Fabristeel Breading Table is a self-contained prep table that allows the operators to dip, bread, sift and rack food efficiently while leaving minimum footprints.


Our breading systems are designed to produce pressured and non-pressured fried food that maintains a consistent look and taste while keeping the costs down and the reduction of breading waste.
